

Making a Pinecone Birdfeeder

This is a fun and exciting activity that should be done under adult supervision.

Supplies:

- One pinecone per person
- One paper plate per person
- One knife for everyone to use
- One small bag of bird seed
- One jar of peanut butter (creamy works best)
- String or ribbon about 12 inches long per person
- One pair of scissors to share

Directions

- 💡 Take the 12 inch piece of ribbon and tie it in a knot around the top part of the pinecone.
- 💡 Take large scoop of peanut butter and put it on a paper plate.
- 💡 Use the knife to spread the peanut butter on the pinecone, making sure you coat the whole thing.
- 💡 Sprinkle the pinecone with birdseed and then roll the pinecone in the birdseed that fell on the plate.
- 💡 Hang the birdfeeder on the tree using the other end of the ribbon.
- 💡 Congratulations! You made a birdfeeder. Have fun watching the birds enjoy their seeds!
